MARYLAND STATE POLICE, CUMBERLAND ADVISED THAT ON NOVEMER! TWENTY IWO, WALTER H. MOELLER, FORMER UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE TENTH DISTRICT OF OHIO AND NOW EMPLOYED NASA, WDC STOPPED AT MSP BARRACKS. HE ADVISED THAT ONE WEEK AGO HE WAS IN CLUB CAR OF AD TRAIN PAREN TRAIN NOT SPECIFIED PAREN AND OVERHEARD A MAN TALKING TO ANOTHER MAIN AND SPEAKING VERY CRITICALLY ABOUT PRESIDENT KENNEDY.
