ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

CAPTAIN J. WALTER MUSTERMAN/NA/, ANNAPOLIS P. D. ADVISED THAT AT ELEVEN A. M. THIS DATE, FREDERICK CHARLES GRIERSON, WHITE, MALE, BORN THREE TWENTY THREE, THIRTY NINE, ANNAPOLIS, MD., FBI NUMBER ONE FIVE FOUR ONE, ONE FIVE THREE C, RESIDING FOUR ZERO THREE PRESIDENT STREET, ANNAPOLIS AND JAMES JOSEPH CANTER, WHITE, MALE, BORN SIX, FIVE, THIRTY THREE, PRINCE GEORGES COUNTY, MD., FBI NUMBER ONE TWO EIGHT ONE NINE FOUR C, WERE ARRESTED ON DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED. THESE INDIVIDUALS OPERATING A NINETEEN FORTY NINE BLACK CHEVROLET CAR, HAD PAINTED IN LARGE LETTERS ON EACH SIDE OF THE CAR WITH WHITE SHOE POLISH, QUOTE, PRESIDENT IS DEAD, WE ARE HAPPY, END QUOTE. INDIVIDUALS ACCORDING TO ANNAPOLIS PD HAVE HAD MINOR TYPE CRIMINAL RECORDS. [BALTIMORE INDICES REFLECT GRIERSON WAS
