LORGIO MORALES, BELL CAPTAIN TRAVELLERS MOTEL, MIAMI ADVISED  
ELEVEN TWENTYFIVE SIXTYTHREE THAT ON NOVEMBER TWENTYTHREE LAST  
AFTER READING IN NEWSPAPER THAT OSWALD HAD BEEN TO RUSSIA,  
OFFERED TO REVEAL ANY OFFICIAL SECRETS WHICH HE HAD LEARNED WHILE  
IN THE U. S. MARINE CORPS, AND HAD BEEN PERMITTED TO REENTER THE  
U. S., HE WAS INCENSED AND MADE A REMARK TO THE EFFECT QUOTE  
WHY WAS HE PERMITTED TO COME BACK INTO THE COUNTRY UNQUOTE.  
MORALES DENIED MAKING ANY STATEMENT THAT FBI AND STATE DEPT. WERE  
RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PRESIDENT/S DEATH. MORALES STATED HE HAD  
CONSIDERED WRITING LETTER TO SENATOR OR CONGRESSMAN BUT  
HAD DECIDED NOT TO DO SO AND DEFINITELY DID NOT WRITE LETTER  
TO ANYONE. IN VIEW OF NON-SPECIFIC NATURE OF MATTER NO FURTHER  
ACTION CONTEMPLATED BY MIAMI.
