**ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT

The following information was telephonically furnished to Mr. Miller of the United States Secret Service at 12:54 pm, November 24, 1963:

At 12:50 pm the FBI Headquarters switchboard operator in Washington, D. C., received an anonymous phone call at which time the caller, who appeared to be a male with an accent, advised that regardless of security "we will get President Johnson today in the parade". The individual then made no further comment.

The following information was furnished to Mr. Grimes of the United States Secret Service at 1:14 pm:

An anonymous call was received by the FBI Headquarters switchboard operator in Washington, D. C., at 1:11 pm at which time the caller stated "you better see that Mr. Kennedy gets out of that parade". No further information was furnished.
