

Q65 Twenty-four miscellaneous megatives (Your item 225)

Result of examination:

Item Q65 contains numerous negatives of identification eards, a birth certificate, type setups of manes, an X ray film and a hanner and sickle design. Where a name appears it is usually LKE HARVEY OSWALD or variations of it along with related descriptive information. The names "George de Mohrenshildt" and "Lee and Marina Oswald" appear in the negatives of type setups. Two of the items are film positives of two corresponding negatives and two others are paper prints of a negative and a film positive.

Eight of the negatives have the names and related information blocked out with photographic opaque. This would be a normal procedure to use in changing the name or other information on identification cards.

Prints of the megatives and X ray are attached along with a photograph showing the information that was blocked out with opaque on the eight negatives described above.
