[Redacted] Washington, D. C. *[Redacted]*
called on 12/2/63. Mr. Clayton in Mr. Tolson's office spoke with her.

[Redacted] advised that on 11/22/63 Billy Graham, the evangelist, spoke over Station WTOP. Graham reportedly said Governor Connally of Texas had come to his room and asked him to get in touch with "Washington" to tell them it was dangerous for the President to come to Dallas. Graham indicated he did so.

[Redacted] advised she had a tape recording of this and if we were interested we should call her.

This question of prior warnings will probably continue to arise. I called SAC Gillies of the Washington Field Office and asked that he have an agent call *[Redacted]* in order to make arrangements to obtain the tape and forward it to the Bureau. Upon receipt it will be reviewed to determine whether the content warrants further action.
