news spread. Heads of diplomatic missions immediately phoned the American Embassy to express their sense of shock and sympathy. The American Ambassador, Mr. Joseph C. Satterthwaite, was in-formed of the President's killing while he was entertaining suests at a dinner party at the Embassy. In a statement issued just an hour after the news of the President's death reached Pretoris the Ambassador said:

## PROFOUND GRIEF

On behalf of the Embassy and our Consulates and of all Ameri-cans in South Africa I can only express our profound grief at the gragic loss of President Kennedy." In the Embasy offices in genitral Pretoria a group of officials with drawn faces listened to the Voice of America as the details of the assassination were unfolded by a sombre-voloed announcer.

The British Ambassador, Bir, Hugh Stephenson, and the Dutch Ambassador, Mr. H. A. Helb, heard news during the interval at the opening performance of the Swan Lake ballet at the Aula in Pretoria.
