ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY,
November 22, 1963

Mr. CEDRIC ALVIN NORRED, who resides at 13756 Hughes Lane, Dallas, Texas, was interviewed November 28, 1963, at JACK BUNTIN Ranch, Fredonia, Texas.

Mr. NORRED denied ever making any allegations of statements to the effect that President JOHN F. KENNEDY and Governor JOHN CONNALLY of Texas should or would be killed. Mr. NORRED admitted that he disagreed with President KENNEDY and Governor CONNALLY in their political policies and had not voted for either individuals, but not to the point of considering harming either person.

Mr. NORRED denied acquaintance with LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK LEON RUBY.

Mr. NORRED informed that he holds membership in the Preston Holland Country Club and the Southwest Road Runners, a group of furniture salesmen, both of Dallas, Texas. He informed he was at the Preston Holland Country Club, Dallas, on November 22, 1963, at the time the assassination of President KENNEDY occurred.

CEDRIC ALVIN NORRED is described as a white male, 51 years old, born August 24, 1912, Dodson, Louisiana, 5'10", 220 pounds, dark brown hair - greying, brown eyes, mustach. He is married with one child and has resided in Dallas, Texas, for the past 13 years.

Mr. NORRED informed he is an independent furniture salesman representing five different furniture companies and maintains a show room at 2000 Stearns Expressway, Dallas, Texas. He stated his territory covers the states of Texas and Oklahoma and includes Shreveport, Louisiana.
