At 10:20 p. m., Legat, Mexico City, Clark Anderson called to advise he had received information that an individual entered Mexico at Nuevo, Laredo, on 9/26/63 under the name Harvey Oswald Lee, age 23; occupation, photographer; residence, New Orleans, Louisiana; destination, Mexico City. This individual was reported going back to U. S. at Nuevo, Laredo, on 10/3/63, traveling via automobile.
