A client of mine, W. T. Dixon, Jr., of Woodland, has asked that I write you regarding the Walter Cronkite coverage of the news at about 3:00 P.M., Sunday, November 24, 1963.

The program showed President Johnson in Berlin. He was speaking to a crowd. The camera showed some members of the crowd. Dixon is convinced that Lee Oswald was in the crowd. Oswald was near the center of the picture facing left when this portion of the program ceased.

Dixon is not a "nut." He is quite deliberate in his actions and thinking. He has asked that I communicate the foregoing to you.
