CHIEF OF POLICE VAN ORT, SUMMIT, ILL., CONTACTED THIS OFFICE THIS DATE AND ADVISED ON NOV. EIGHT, OR NOV. NINE, LAST RECEIVED IN U. S. MAIL ENVELOPE ADDRESSED TO CHIEF OF POLICE, SUMMIT, ILL. ENVELOPE CONTAINED SEVERAL NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS ON MEETING OF TWENTY SECOND COMMUNIST CONGRESS, MOSCOW.

CHIEF VAN ORT STATED ENVELOPE POSTMARKED NATCHEZ, MISS. AND FRONT OF ENVELOPE CARRIED STATEMENT QUOTE KICK KENNEDY OUT IN SIXTY FOUR END QUOTE. FRONT OF ENVELOPE ALSO CONTAINED RETURN ADDRESS STICKER BEARING NAME AND ADDRESS OF H. L. HUNT, ONE SEVEN ZERO FOUR MAIN STREET, DALLAS, TEX.

STICKER DID NOT APPEAR IN USUAL PLACE WHERE RETURN STICKER ORDINARILY APPEARS.

DALLAS SHOULD CONSIDER INTERVIEWING HUNT RE SHOOTING OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.
