WOULD SEE A MAN NAMED QUOTE OSWALD END QUOTE.

EXTENSIVE INVESTIGATION IN DENVER REFLECTS THAT [REDACTED]  
JOHN G. FLOBECK, C. EDWIN BUSH AND H. GREGORY AUSTIN JR., WERE  
ATTENDING PARTY OF A LOCAL BACHELORS CLUB AT PETROLEUM BUILD-  
ING, DENVER IN MARCH NINETEEN SIXTY TWO. DURING PARTY, HARRY  
NIER WHO WAS PRESENT, PARTICIPATED IN EXTENSIVE DISCUSS

AND ARGUMENT PRIMARILY WITH [REDACTED] AND FLOBECK. NIER WAS CRITICAL OF U. S. PRESS REPORTS ON CONDITIONS IN CUBA, NIER ADMITTED BEING MARXIST, AND MENTIONED HE WAS GOING TO EITHER CUBA OR MEXICO IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

BUSH, FLOBECK AND AUSTIN DO NOT RECALL THAT NIER MENTIONED ANY INDIVIDUAL NAMED QUOTE OSWALD END QUOTE.

PRESS REPORTS INDICATE THAT LEE OSWALD WAS IN USSR NINETEEN FIFTY NINE THROUGH MAY NINETEEN SIXTY TWO. IT APPEARS IMPROBABLE THAT NIER WAS REFERRING TO LEE OSWALD IN MARCH NINETEEN SIXTY TWO.

IN TV INTERVIEW, DENVER, NOVEMBER TWENTY TWO LAST, NIER DENIED KNOWING OSWALD.

HOWEVER IN ORDER TO DEFINITELY RESOLVE THIS MATTER, BUREAU AUTHORITY REQUESTED TO INTERVIEW HARRY NIER.

NIER KNOWN TO BE IN DENVER NOVEMBER TWENTY FIVE LAST.
