MRS. MARIE PULTS

At 11:15 p.m., November 27, 1963, Security Clerk DAVID A. WALL received a telephone call from JERRY GALVAN, 162 Lively Drive, San Antonio, Texas. GALVAN explained that several weeks ago he and his family were close friends of ROBERT PULTS, 215 Wonder Park Drive, San Antonio, Texas. There was some misunderstanding between them and recently they have not been associated with each other. GALVAN stated that MARIE PULTS is presently soliciting donations for the widow of LEE HARVEY OSWALD. For some reason unknown to GALVAN, his name has become involved with this solicitation and he has received telephonic threats.

GALVAN has discussed this with his Attorney and was told by his Attorney to take a witness and discuss this matter with MARIE PULTS. According to GALVAN, he was told by Mr. PULTS that Mrs. PULTS was in Dallas at that time, and he knew nothing about GALVAN's name being used in the solicitation. GALVAN was reluctant to furnish the information concerning the telephonic threats to the San Antonio Police Department.

The above facts were telephonically furnished by Special Agent MORTON P. CHILES, JR. to Lt. JOHN GARONI, San Antonio Police Department at approximately 11:30 p.m., November 27, 1963, for any action deemed appropriate.
