ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY NOVERBELL 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS

On November 29, 1963, Mr. T. H. QUINLAN, Braniff International Airways, made available flight records for all flights from San Antonio to Dallas for October 3, 1963. A check of these records failed to reflect any person identifiable with LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ALEK JAMES HIDELL, or O. H. LEE. The following flights were checked:

These records are retained only two months, so, records for October 3, 1963, will be destroyed December 3, 1963.

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
