GUNSMITH IN BIRMINGHAM AND MOBILE. HE BRAGGED HE WAS RUNCING

RIFLES TO ANTI CASTRO GROUP IN MIAMI. HE CLAIMED HE BROUGHT

GUNS IN HIS CAR AND THIS WAS THE REASON TWO YOUNG CUDANS MET HIM

UPON HIS ARRIVAL AT [MOTEL] [REDACTED] RECALLED THAT TWO YOUNG CUBANS

NET SUBJECT UPON HIS ARRIVAL ON EACH OCCASION HE TOOK CAR AWAY
GUISE OF TAKING IT TO A CAR WASH.

SUBJECT CLAIMED CUBAN OFFICER OF ANTI CASTRO GROUP. SUBJECT
MADE LONG DISTANCE CALLS BIRMINGHAM AND MOBILE. ON LAST TRIP IN
AUGUST, HE DISPLAYED A HIGH POWERED TWENTYTWO CALIBER RIFLE, A
TYPE GUN HE WAS FURNISHING CUBANS. ON LAST TRIP IN AUGUST. SUBJECT
BRAGGED THE ANTI CASTRO GROUP HAD LET A CONTRACT OR OFFERED
REWARD OF TWENTYFIVE TO FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR SOMEONE TO GET
KENNEDY. [REDACTED] IF HE MEANT BOBBY AND SUBJECT REPLIED
THAT HE MEANT BOTH OF THEM. SUBJECT DURING HIS STAYS WAS VERY
PROLIFIC IN HIS CONDEMNATION OF THE UNITED STATES FOR NOT SUPPORTING
THE ANTI CASTRO CUBAN INVASION EFFORTS. [REDACTED] BELIEVED SUBJECT
TO BE A BRAGGART AND STATED HE HAD ONLY KNOWN HIM FOR A PERIOD WHEN
THE SUBJECT HAD BEEN AT [THE MOTEL]. SUBJECT ALSO CLAIMS HE HAD BEEN
TO CUBA.

IN VIEW OF SUBJECTS ALLEGED ACTIVITIES AND HIS STATEMENT
CONCERNING THE PRESIDENT, MIAMI SHOULD CONDUCT LOGICAL INVESTIGATION
AT [JAMAICA MOTEL] TO FULLY IDENTIFY SUBJECT, DETERMINE LOCATION AND
INTERVIEW CONCERNING THE STATEMENT HE HAS MADE. BIRMINGHAM AND
MOBILE ADVISE MIAMI IF SUBJECT KNOWN THEIR FILES. BUREAU AND
DALLAS FURNISHED INFORMATION COPIES.
