Remarks:

K39 was among the items personally delivered to the Laboratory on 11/27/63, by Agents of your office.

You will be advised separately regarding the latent fingerprint examination of K39.

For your investigative assistance, it was noted that the rubber stamp wording "New Orleans, La." on Qc52 matches closely the present rubber stamp setting on K39 and could have come from K39. The other rubber stamp impressions on Qc52 are of the same size and style as the rubber type on K39.

For your investigative assistance, a few handwriting similarities were noted common to the questioned signature "A. J. Hideel" and the available known writings of OSWALD.

If available, submit the original certificate of vaccination for further laboratory examination.

**Qc52 Xerox copy of International Certificate of Vaccination
against Smallpox in the name "Lee H. Oswald"**

K39 Box containing "Warrior Rubber Stamping Kit" (item #283)

Result of examination:

It was concluded that K39 was used to prepare the entire rubber stamp impression on the handbill, Q44, previously submitted and the rubber stamp wording "New Orleans, La." on Q43 and Q45.

Qc52 is a Xerox copy of the original vaccination certificate and is not sufficiently clear for a rubber stamp comparison.

It was concluded that the hand printing and the Oswald signature on Qc52 were written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case. The signature "A. J. Hidde1" on Qc52 is distorted and not sufficiently comparable with the available known writings of OSWALD to warrant a definite conclusion.

The submitted evidence is retained.
