It was concluded that K39 was used to prepare the entire rubber stamp impression on the handbill, Q44, previously submitted and the rubber stamp wording "New Orleans, Ia." on Q43 and Q45. 

Qc52 is a Zerox copy of the original vaccination certificate and is not sufficiently clear for a rubber stamp , comparison.

It was concluded that the hand printing and the 'Oswald signature on Qc52 were written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case. The signature "A. J. Hideel" on Qc52 is distorted and not sufficiently comparable with the available known writings of OSWALD To warrant a definite conclusion.
