HE HAD FOREIGN SERVICE IN JAPAN AND KOREA AND WAS AWARDED UNITED NATIONS MEDAL, KOREAN SERVICE MEDAL WITH TWO BRONZE SERVICE STARS AND THE NATIONAL DEFENSE SERVICE MEDAL. HIS RECORD CONTAINED STATEMENT DATED JULY FIFTEEN, FIFTY-TWO, WHICH REFLECTED QUOTE THE FOLLOWING INDUCTEE PAINE, MICHAEL R. WAS INDUCTED TODAY, FIFTEEN JULY, FIFTY-TWO, BUT REFUSED TO TAKE THE OATH OF ALLEGIANCE ENQUOTE.

HIS CHARACTER AND EFFICIENCY RATINGS RANGED FROM UNKNOWN TO EXCELLENT AND THERE WERE NO RECORDS OF COURTS-MARTIAL OR ABSENCE WITHOUT OFFICIAL LEAVE.
