ON DECEMBER FIVE INSTANT PATROLMAN MARVIN MEYERS, COVINGTON, KY., PD ADVISED SA JOHN M. BARRY THAT APPROXIMATELY TWO OR THREE WEEKS AGO ON A THURSDAY OR FRIDAY AFTERNOON, HE HAD JUST COME ON DUTY AT HIS POST IN DOWNTOWN COVINGTON, KY., AND WAS IN COPPINS DEPARTMENT STORE, SEVENTH AND MADISON TALKING TO BILL SCHNELL, WATCH REPAIRMAN FOR COPPINS, WHICH TIME WAS SHORTLY AFTER ONE O-CLOCK PM WHEN AN OLD WOMAN, WHOM HE DESCRIBED AS BEING WELL DRESSED, OVER SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE, BUT NO FURTHER DESCRIPTION, APPROACHED HE AND SCHNELL AND SAID QUOTE I HEARD THE PRESIDENT HAS BEEN STOP END QUOTE.
