RECORDS OF DALLAS OFFICE REFLECT OSWALD INTERVIEWED AT FORT  
WORTH, TEXAS, ON JUNE TWENTYSIX, SIXTYTWO, BY SAS JOHN W. FAIN  
AND B. TOM CARTER, AND ON AUGUST SIXTEEN, SIXTYTWO, BY SAS JOHN  
W. FAIN AND ARNOLD J. BROWN, AS REFLECTED RESPECTIVELY IN THE  
REPORTS OF SA FAIN DATED JULY TEN, SIXTYTWO, AND AUGUST THIRTY,  
SIXTY, TWO, AT DALLAS. NO OTHER INTERVIEWS OF OSWALD, UP UNTIL  
THOSE CONDUCTED FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY,  
HAVE BEEN CONDUCTED BY THE DALLAS DIVISION.

DALLAS RECORDS SHOW OSWALD WAS INTERVIEWED ON AUGUST TEN,  
LAST, BY SA JOHN LESTER QUIGLEY AT NEW ORLEANS FOLLOWING THE  
ARREST THERE OF OSWALD BY THE NEW ORLEANS, PD, ON AUGUST NINE LAST.

FOR DISTURBING THE PEACE AS REFLECTED IN THE REPORT OF SA MILTON R. KAACK DATED OCT. THIRTYONE LAST AT NEW ORLEANS. DALLAS FILES REFLECT NO OTHER INTERVIEWS OF OSWALD BY THE NEW ORLEANS FIELD DIVISION.

ON NOV. ONE LAST, SA JAMES P. HOSTY, JR., AFTER ESTABLISHING HER RELIABILITY, INTERVIEWED MRS. MICHAEL R. /RUTH/ PAINE AT TWO FIVE ONE FIVE FIFTH ST., IRVING, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ATTEMPTING TO ASCERTAIN THE LOCATION OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD WHEN NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTIGATION IN THAT VICINITY ESTABLISHED OSWALD'S WIFE, MARINA NIKOLAEVNA OSWALD, WAS LIVING THERE WITH MRS. PAINE BUT OSWALD ONLY VISITED THERE PERIODICALLY. MRS. PAINE WAS FRIENDLY AND COOPERATIVE AND ADVISED OSWALD WAS WORKING AT THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY, FOUR ONE ONE ELM ST., DALLAS, AND MAINTAINED A ROOM IN DALLAS, THE EXACT ADDRESS OF WHICH SHE DID NOT KNOW.

IN THE COURSE OF THE INTERVIEW WITH MRS. PAINE, SUBJECT'S WIFE ENTERED THE ROOM AND UPON LEARNING THE IDENTITY OF SA HOSTY

SHOWED SOME EVIDENCE OF ALARM. MRS. OSWALD IS AN ALIEN RUSSIAN AND SPEAKS AND UNDERSTANDS ENGLISH ONLY TO LIMITED DEGREE. SHE WAS ASSURED BY SA HOSTY, THROUGH MRS. PAINE, WHO SPEAKS RUSSIAN, SA HOSTY WAS NOT THERE TO HARASS OR MOLEST HER IN ANY WAY. SHE WAS NOT INTERVIEWED NOR APPROACH OF ANY KIND MADE TO HER TO OBTAIN INFORMATION OR SUGGEST SHE FURNISH INFORMATION TO THE FBI. NO REMARKS CONCERNING THE FBI/S INTEREST IN HER HUSBAND WERE MADE TO HER.

SA JAMES P. HOSTY IS EVIDENTLY THE AGENT JAMES P. HASTY REFERRED TO IN RETELCALL.
