[REDACTED] Cornelison Avenue, Jersey City, New Jersey, advised that the company's sales manager, Hans Peters, a German National, who has been in the United States approximately one year, in a report to the company, advised the following information:

Peters stated that on November 22, 1963, prior to the assassination he contacted R. L. CULBERSON, Broadway Pet Shop, 4010 Broadway, San Antonio, Texas, to inventory his stock of tropical fish and pet literature. Culberson refused to permit this inventory and began to lecture Peters on American International Policy and attacked President Kennedy and Vice President Johnson in an ugly manner. Peters revealed he refused to discuss this matter with Culberson and departed.

[REDACTED] advised Peters resides at 26 Citidel Drive, Jackson, New Jersey, and is expected to return during December 15 - 17, 1963. She added that Peters calls T. F. H. each Wednesday and Thursday concerning his whereabouts.
