SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT John F. Kennedy

D.C. X Mr. Robert R. X Lochrie, Administrative Assistant to Congressman Paul G. Rogers (D-Florida), called at 12:40 p.m. today and advised that a constituent of the Congressman by the name of Arthur Sweeney was staying at the Marriott Motel, Room 525 (Twin Bridges) and that he, Sweeney, had heard some conversation last fall in Oklahoma which involved around "eliminating" the President.

Mr. Lochrie said that Mr. Sweeney is from Cape Coral, Florida, that he, Lochrie, has no further details, but thought perhaps we might like to talk to him.
