 BALL END QUOTE AND AS A COMMUNIST. SOURCE STATED THAT GEORGE  
 HEIDEL REPORTEDLY LEFT WESTCHESTER COUNTY SEPT. OR OCT., NINETEEN  
 SIXTYTHREE TO RESIDE IN TEXAS. SOURCE UNABLE TO IDENTIFY GEORGE
