Enclosed herewith for examination by the FBI Laboratory is one original Polaroid photograph taken by JACK A. WEAVER, 829 Fidelity Union Life Building, Dallas, Texas, on 11/22/63 depicting the automobile occupied by President JOHN F. KENNEDY, Mrs. KENNEDY, Texas Governor JOHN B. CONNALLY and Mrs. CONNALLY during the President's motorcade through downtown Dallas.

This photograph was made as the President's car was making a right turn onto Houston Street from Main Street and in the background of this photograph in the lefthand section appears the 7 story building housing the Texas School Book Depository. From the time of this photograph until the time of President KENNEDY'S assassination, this car traveled one block toward the Texas School Book Depository Building, made a left turn onto Elm Street in front of this building. The assassin allegedly is located in the sixth floor window on the extreme righthand side of the face of the Texas School Book Depository Building.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to make an enlargement or study of this photograph to determine whether or not it is possible to identify or distinguish the assassin who would, to the time of the photograph, possibly be waiting in the sixth floor righthand window.

Following the requested examination of this photograph should be returned to the Dallas Office in order that it may be returned to the contributor.
