On 12/3/63, WILLIAM H. JOHNSON, Assistant Passenger Traffic Manager, Lykes Brothers Steamship Company, Room 1300, Commerce Building, New Orleans, La., made available copies of the Passenger Revenue Manifest for the SS Marion Lykes, Voyage 110, with indicated sailing date from New Orleans 9/19/59. This list shows identity of passengers sailing, including LEE HARVEY OSWALD, age 19, permanent address Fort Worth, Texas, Passport #1733242, and port of debarkation Le Havre, France.

It is noted that the voyage letter by Captain WILLIAM E. ALLEY shows that the vessel sailed from New Orleans at 6:24 A.M. on 9/20/63. The exact sailing time from New Orleans and arrival at Le Havre, France, is being verified by a review of U. S. Shipping Company records at Galveston, Texas.
