On 12/5/63, HUGH M. HARRIS, Graves Mill Rd., Lynchburg, Va., telephonically contacted the Lynchburg Resident Agency and stated he had phoned the Bureau regarding the assassination of the President, claiming that he was going to investigate the crime and was going to arrange for the Army to be stationed with tanks in every city and town to fight the Communist. He alleged he planned to go to Washington, D.C. in the near future and was going to go to the Bureau to help in the investigation of the assassination.

HARRIS is known to this office as a mental case who periodically contacts the Lynchburg RA claiming to have information about bank robbers, gangsters and other members of the criminal element.

This data is furnished for the information of the Bureau in the event he should contact the Bureau personally or by phone.
