Assassination of President John F. Kennedy

Gentlemen:

Our local paper, the Telegram-Tribune, has an article on the front page this evening that reads as follows:

"FBI DENIES REPORT OF PHOTOGRAPH
Dallas (UPI) -- Reports on television of a photograph showing two persons in the window from which a sniper is believed to have killed President John F. Kennedy were denied by the Federal Bureau of Investigation today.

The FBI said it had seen no such photograph."

On Friday, November 22, 1963, between the hours of approximately 6:00 and 7:00 P.M. such a picture was shown on television on Channel 6. I saw two people at an upstairs window and I saw them run from the window and it looked as though one of them had a gun.

I feel that unless this television picture, which must have been seen by millions, is explained, that confidence will be lost in the FBI.
