Pierre Salinger called from the White House at 3:30 p. m. this afternoon. He stated that his office is receiving considerable pressure from the press as to when the FBI report will be ready to be made public. He wanted to know what I could tell him in this regard. I told Salinger that for his information, the report would undoubtedly be sent to the Attorney General this week; however, we, of course, had no idea as to when the Attorney General would turn the report over to the President.

Salinger asked if we knew whether the President would make this report public. I told him this, of course, would be up to the President. I mentioned that the President might desire to make it public or he might turn it over to the Presidential Commission. I further mentioned that undoubtedly Chief Justice Warren would have some ideas regarding this matter. Salinger stated he would speak to the President about the matter.
