"JOCK"

On December 4, 1963, Raymond L. Sanders, 941 South Lake Street, Los Angeles, California, telephonically contacted the Los Angeles Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and advised as follows:

Sanders stated that he had just had breakfast at Biffs Cafe, 7th and Alvarado Streets, Los Angeles, and that he had a conversation with "Jock," the night cook. He stated that "Jock" advised that President John F. Kennedy got just what was coming to him; that they will get Robert Kennedy, Mrs. John F. Kennedy, and the "whole Kennedy clan" plus President Lyndon Johnson and his wife. "Jock" further stated that if he had the chance or anything to do with it, he would do the "job" himself. He contended that "Murder, Incorporated," was behind the assassination of President Kennedy.
