ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT John F. Kennedy *Myers*
 REMY PHONE CALL DECEMBER 3 LAST.
 INDIVIDUAL WHO CONTACTED THIS OFFICE OFFERING TO
 FURNISH INFORMATION RE OSWALD AND HIS ACTIVITIES IN
 RUSSIA ARRESTED BY DST DECEMBER 4. HE IS FRENCH
 NATIONAL NAMED STEPHANE CISOWSKI, BORN MAY 5, 1936
 AT CHARNY, FRANCE. HE HAS NEVER VISITED RUSSIA. KNOWS
 NOTHING OF OSWALD, HAS NO DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO
 OSWALD AND HAS ADMITTED HE INVENTED ENTIRE STORY.
 BELIEVED TO BE ABNORMAL MENTALLY. PRESENTLY IN CUSTODY
 OF PREFECTURE OF POLICE, PARIS.

FRENCH POLICE HAVE REQUESTED BE ADVISED IF EMBASSY
 WISHES TO FILE COMPLAINT AND IF THEY HAVE OBJECTION TO
 PUBLICITY IN CONNECTION WITH THIS ARREST. THIS BEING
 LEFT TO DECISION OF EMBASSY OFFICIALS. IT APPEARS THEY
 WILL NOT FILE COMPLAINT AND DO NOT WANT PUBLICITY
 REGARDING HIS ATTEMPT TO SELL INFO TO EMBASSY. *62-109262-1743*
 BUREAU WILL BE ADVISED IF PUBLICITY TO BE RELEASED BY DST
 RECOMMEND LETTER TO DANIEL DOUTIN, DIRECTOR OF DST
 COMMENDING AUGUSTE SAUZON, ALAIN MONTARRAS, AND ROBERT
 DESHEREAU FOR THEIR PROMPT AND EFFECTIVE HANDLING OF
 THIS MATTER.
