Enclosed for New York and Dallas is a copy of a letter to the Attorney General from Miss A. Nanet Adams dated 12/2/63 which was forwarded to us by the Department.

The letter, which is self-explanatory, indicates Miss Adams has some information concerning the assassination of President Kennedy. Bureau files indicate that the New York Office has had prior experience with Miss Adams and considered her to be mentally unstable; however, in view of the gravity of this particular investigation and the alleged information in Miss Adams' possession, New York is instructed to promptly interview Miss Adams, acknowledge receipt of her letter to the Attorney General and determine what information she has concerning the assassination. The results of your inquiry should be promptly submitted to the Bureau and Dallas in a form suitable for dissemination.

The above letter was received at the Bureau on referral from the Department of Justice. Bureau files indicate that by letter dated 11/17/60, New York advised Miss Adams had been in contact with the New York Office, on several occasions and was considered by personnel interviewing her to be mentally unstable. While it is highly improbable she will have any information of pertinence to this investigation, it is still in view of her letter to the Attorney General and the gravity of this case she be interviewed. The results of New York's inquiry will be furnished to the Department and Secret Service.
