ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY November 22, 1963 DALLAS TEXAS

bus driver for the San Antonic Transit Company, advised that on Saturda. November 16, 1963, he had a conversation with two other bus drivers, namely; REBER LAPHITE, and a concerning President KENNEDY.

Concerning President KENNEDY.

A said that WHITE made the remark that he hoped President KENNEDY would be killed before the next election, calling KENNEDY a communist and a dictator. WHITE then said, "By the way, he is also to be assassinated between now and December 3, 1963." He described WHITE as white, male, age 50, 6' in height, 170-180 pounds, with black hair,

Mr. REBER C. WHITE was interviewed at his home, 1531 West Hollywood, by a Special Agent of the FBI. Mr. WHITE denied that he had given any date by which time President KENNEDY would be assassinated. During his conversation with the two other bus drivers, and he explained that he had told these two men about an article he had read which indicated that every twenty years a President is assassinated or dies in office.
