publishing the article concerning the two letters.

The anonymous communication signed "A Worker" which was turned over to the Dallas Office, by MRS. GASSAWAY, was located in Dallas files and is the enclosure hereto.

It is requested a comparison be made between the handwriting in the enclosed anonymous communication and the known handwriting of LEE HARVEY OSWALD already in possession of the Live Bureau Laboratory, for the purpose of determining whether the anonymous communication was or was not written by him. Results should be made available to the Dallas Office.
