SSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63 DALLAS, TEXAS

Reference is made to Bureau teletype to Dallas on 12/6/63, in which Dallas was requested to endeavor to trace the sling on Oswald's rifle. Lee Harvey Xoswald

Enclosed are four photographs of each side of this sling

The slingais composed of cowhide which has been finished on the outside with a smooth black surface. The inside is a rough, natural brown, unstained surface. The wide portion of the sling as Photo in the photographs is 2" wide and 92" In length. A chrome-plated ring is fastened to each end of this vide piece by a strap riveted to the wide piece with two black givets. To each ring is riveted a 32" piece of 3/4" strap. A buckle is riveted to the end of each of the short straps. Onto this buckle is fastened a 3/4" strap which is 43" in length. It is apparent that this strap was longer since each end has been dut off subsequent to manufacture. Fourteen buckle-tongue holes appear in each end of the long strap, apparently made during manufacture. The holes used to mount the sling to the rifle, however, appear to be handmade and are located in from each end.
