RE CHICAGO TELETYPE DECEMBER TWO RELATING TO ANTI CASTRO INVOLVEMENT, CHICAGO.

SECRET SERVICE AGENTS JOSEPH NOONAN AND EDWARD TUCKER ADVISED DECEMBER ELEVEN LAST THAT THEIR SOURCE CONTINUES TO MEET WITH AND UNIDENTIFIED CUBAN, BUT NO FURTHER DETAILS WORKED OUT AS TO SALE OF GUNS OR EXPLOSIVES. UNIDENTIFIED CUBAN-S ONLY COMMENT CONCERNING PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS THAT HE HAD PLAYED BOTH SIDES OF THE FENCE ON THE CUBAN QUESTION IN ORDER TO SAVE POLITICAL FACE.

\*SECRET SERVICE, CHICAGO, PLANS ANOTHER MEET TO DETERMINE SENTIMENTS OF UNIDENTIFIED CUBAN AND HIS ORGANIZATION. DEVELOPS REFLECTING ON ASSASSINATION, SECRET SERVICE WILL TURN COMPLETE INVESTIGATION OVER TO U. S. CUSTOMS, CHICAGO, WHICH, ACCORDING TO SECRET SERVICE, HAS BEEN ADVISED OF CURRENT INVESTIGATION
