[redacted] stated that [redacted] recalled making the remark in question but that it is [redacted] opinion that this information related to a plan of the group of GUTIERREZ MENOYO to carry out the military action against the Communist Government of Cuba and in no way related to the assassination of President KENNEDY. [redacted] said that with Cubans coming to the store and talking among themselves as well as with [redacted] hears all sorts of rumors regarding the Cuban situation. [redacted] said that [redacted] was unable to recall who told [her] about the possible action on the part of the GUTIERREZ MENOYO group. CAUSA also mentioned that [redacted]

[redacted] RAFAEL DOMINGUEZ CABALLERO, a member of GUTIERREZ MENOYO's group, but that this was not the source of the rumor regarding the possible action by the organization of GUTIERREZ MENOYO. [redacted] stated that [redacted] had absolutely no information regarding the assassination of President KENNEDY.

Inasmuch as this matter related to the Cuban situation and obviously had no connection with the assassination, no further action is contemplated by the Miami Division.
