On 12/5/63, Mr. PETE FINNELLY, WBIR Radio-TV Station, Knoxville, Tenn., gave to SA HERBERT C. MAYS a postcard which Mr. FINNELLY described as "odd", which card had been received in the mail by WBIR. Mr. FINNELLY advised the above card has absolutely no meaning to him or others at the station. The postcard bears on the front thereof what appears to be the return address of [JOSEPH MOSTECKI,] Sheraton Biltmore Hotel, Providence, Rhode Island, addressed to Station WBIR, Knoxville 2, Tennessee, and written on front "Don't forget your gloves! I. M."

On reverse side is as follows:

"December 2, 1963, The Boys: 1935-1945.
President J. F. Kennedy 35th president of the U.S.A.
Killed in Action: 11-22-63
'Your backs are protected.'
'Pray for Peace'
Only a Police Action, Undercover, Regular Army
