There is also enclosed herewith for the information of the Bureau one copy of the "Background Memorandum" prepared by ANDREW ST. GEORGE from which he hoped to write a story to be published in "Life" Magazine concerning his personal opinions relative to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. Information contained in the memorandum from ANDREW ST. GEORGE was not submitted in form suitable for dissemination, as ST. GEORGE gave this to the NYO on a confidential basis and requested that those made available as he was preparing to write an article and hoped to sell it to some national magazine.

There is also enclosed for the information of the Bureau the article appearing in the 12/9/63 issue of "US News and World Report" relative to the possible indirect connection with the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

GEORGE, he stated that JOSE PANDO LLADA had informed him that he had been interviewed on numerous occasions by CIA lafter his defection in February, 1961] PANDO LLADA stated that he had given CIA detailed information concerning the Cuban situation and had also furnished the CIA with the contents of the enclosed letterhead memorandum relative to the plan of FIDEL CASTRO to have U.S. Ambassadors assassinated in the event of a U.S. invasion of Cuba.
