[REDACTED] WE HAVE LEARNED THAT ON 3 DECEMBER 1963, A KNOWN SOVIET INTELLIGENCE OFFICER IN NEW DELHI, INDIA, WORKING THRU INDIAN COMMUNISTS, ATTEMPTED TO HAVE A NUMBER OF TELEGRAMS SENT TO PRESIDENT JOHNSON, CHIEF JUSTICE WARREN, AND ATTORNEY GENERAL KENNEDY FROM INDIAN YOUTH, LEGAL, AND OTHER GROUPS, DEMANDING A FULL PROBE INTO THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY. APPARENTLY THE SOVIET OFFICER UNDERTOOK TO PAY FOR ALL THE TELEGRAMS; HE SAID THE WHOLE SCHEME WAS BASED ON "ORDERS FROM [REDACTED] RECON."
