Inspector THOMAS J. KELLEY, U. S. Secret Service, Dallas, Texas, by letter dated 12/4/63, furnished the following information:

"We have been requested to secure copies of the following documents of LEE HARVEY OSWALD for the purpose of Social Security claims on behalf of his widow and children:

Birth certificates for children Marriage certificate U. S. Marine Discharge from military service

"It is our understanding that these papers were removed from OSWALD's residence by Dallas Police and turned over to the FBI for review."

From a check of our inventory of items furnished the Laboratory from OSWALD's belongings received from the Police Department, we believe the following items should be furpished:
