Inspector THOMAS J. KELLEY, U. S. Secret Service, Dallas, Texas, by letter dated 12/4/63, furnished the following information:

"We have been requested to secure copies of the following documents of LEE HARVEY OSWALD for the purpose of Social Security claims on behalf of his widow and children:

- Birth certificates for children
- Marriage certificate *434 ✓*
- U. S. Marine Discharge from military service

"It is our understanding that these papers were removed from OSWALD's residence by Dallas Police and turned over to the FBI for review."

From a check of our inventory of items furnished the Laboratory from OSWALD's belongings received from the Police Department, we believe the following items should be furnished:
