Proceed
On Tuesday, December 3, 1963, Mr. Cleve Herman, sportscaster and news commentator on Radio Station K.F.W.B., announced that an F. B. I. report on the assassination of J. F. Kennedy, was to be presented to Atty. General, Robert Kennedy. He stated the report would be a closing report and that it would indicate that Lee Oswald was a "Loner", not part of a conspiracy; but that sufficient evidence existed to establish him in fact, as the assassin of the president.

|| It is incredible, if true, that such a report could be foisted on the American people as the final chapter in the death of the president.

|| I for one, would not accept such a report unless it contained also a statement to the effect that Oswald was in the least, a Marxist, and more probably a Communist; and that either political school was the background for his ultimate act. This being true, the report should recommend, that all political groups dedicated to the overthrow of the United States government be outlawed and abolished. Further, that all known members of any such group be imprisoned as enemies of the government and peoples of the United States.
