On 12/2/63 [REDACTED] that a check had been made of the following records on OSWALD: American Embassy.

[REDACTED] These checks were completely negative.

[REDACTED] stated Stockholm newspapers on 11/25/63 reported OSWALD obtained his Soviet visa in Stockholm in 1959 after being unable to get the visa in Helsinki, Finland. The news account said OSWALD had remained in Stockholm for two days. A check of all records in Stockholm were negative.
