SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

Reference is made to Miami teletype dated December 8, 1963, setting forth information received from Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) [redacted] (S) This CIA information was obtained by the Agency from a [redacted] diplomat, unidentified, alleging that the assassination of President Kennedy was the result of a plot executed jointly by Chinese Communists and Fidel Castro through intermediaries. Liaison was instructed to press CIA for additional specifics concerning the source and reliability of the information.

On December 9, 1963, the Liaison Agent informed [redacted] CIA, that the Bureau would like to have the following:

- (1) Identity of the diplomat
- (2) Access to him
- (3) Identity of the diplomat's original source
- (4) Any other details which might assist us in evaluating the allegation.

Subsequent to the above action, [redacted] (S) advised the Liaison Agent that the diplomat was connected with [redacted] and because of his [redacted] position, his identity could not be furnished at this time. CIA does not know the diplomat's original source but is endeavoring to obtain such information. The diplomat has furnished CIA information in the past and much of his information "has not been too reliable."

Under further questioning by the Liaison Agent, [redacted] (S) explained that the diplomat was not in the U.S. and was in an area where he could not be contacted by the Bureau. In addition, CIA does not deal directly with him [redacted] (S)
