NOTE: J. C. Burton telephonically advised our Charlotte office that in approximately July or August, 1963, he had overheard a person describe how the assassination of the President could be effected and after the assassination he felt this matter should be brought to the attention of the FBI. He allegedly heard this statement made by an individual in a restaurant of a motel in South Carolina. He identified the manager of this restaurant and Savannah is making efforts to locate and interview the manager to ascertain the identity of the individual making the statements relating to the President's assassination. In view of the importance of this particular investigation, it is felt this matter should be appropriately resolved and disseminated to Secret Service.
