ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY November 22, 1963 DALLAS. TEXAS

It 3:45 p.m. December 5, 1963, Mrs. W. L. HAMM, employed by the Trinity Faptist Church, 300 East Mulberry Street, San Antonio, stated that an individual named GIENN MARKWELL or GIENN MART WELL had called the church several to San Antonio from Houston, Texas, by Brown Express and that en route to San Antonio his car was in an accident and demolished and his hillfold lost. He indicated his address was coming in by bus and he had no food for them and needed

upon his arrival in San Antonio he learned that the Brown Express was laying off men and there was no job and that he had applied for employment at the employment agency. MARKWELL indicated that he had been referred to the Baptist Church by a minister in Fouston.

Mrs. HAMM advised that the church checked with Mrs. WILLIE CRAMER, 100 Ninth Street, San Antonio. Mrs CRAMER indicated that MARKWELL had been roaming the area but had disappeared on the day prior to the assassination of former President KENNEDY and that until the call from

the church, Mrs. CPAMER had not heard of the subject or seen him. Mrs. CFAMER advised Mrs. HAMM that MARKWELL had informed her that he had once defected to Russia and was also known by the names of ROGER and GEORGE. MARKWELL or Laredo but no reason was given. Mrs. CRAMER stated that WELL was receiving mail under the name of GLENN MARKWELL.

Mrs. HAMM was contacted on December 5, 1963, at the Irinity Baptist Church regarding MARKWELL and she stated that she had not met him or even heard of him prior to his telephone call. She stated that when she spoke to him early in the day he appeared to be above average in intelligence, was polite. not demanding, and stated that he was coming over. She informed MARKWELL at this time that the church would be open to give him food until 5:00 p.m., however, this hour came and passed and MARKWELL never showed.

Mrs. HAMI was again contacted at approximately 3:30 p.m. December 6, 1963, and she advised that she had not seen or heard from NARKWELL nor has anyone else at the church.

Mrs. W. E. CHAMER was contacted by telephone on the evening of December 5, 1963, and she advised that she was suffering from a virus infection and laryngitis, which was very noticeable on the telephone and requested that the interview be postponed until the morning of December 6, 1963.

On December 6, 1963, Mrs. W. E. CRAMER, also known as WILLIE CRAMER, was contacted at her residence 100 Ninth Street, San Antonio. She stated that about Toxa November 5, 1963, she met a boy who was residing in an apartment next to the building where her apartment is located. She stated that she understood he first took occupance of his apartment around November 1, 1963. She

advised that after he had introduced himself to her as CLERN MARKERIA he saired pair ission to use her telephone. Sie a'sted that he used it a number of times and said he was calling his girlfriend but she has no idea of the number he was calling or the identity of the girlfriend. He also informed Mrs. CRAMER that he was a Baptist preacher and had come to Sin Artonio from Dallas, Texas, where he worked as a rish tith entartainer and singer. He said that he had served in the . E. Armed Force and had an honorable discharge. He said that he had been caught by the Communists in Viet Wiem while sending in the U.S. Armed Forces and held prisoner for nearly two years. MARKWELL stated that he hallilled two Communist guards in an effort to effect his escape from prisoner of war camp. He advised that he was short of funds and Mrs. CRAMER suggested that he contact the American Legion for assistance but he said they were not worth the space they take up. He stated that write en route to San Artonio he had had an accident and his car was almost completely destroyed and it was presently in a garage lut did not say where. He advised that he has been working for a trucking company but did not say where. He said that some people call him GEORGE MARIWELL, but that his correct name is ROGER MARKWELL. Mrs. CRAMER claimed that he had disappeared from his residence on Nevember 8, 1963 for three days, again on the Nevember 17, 1963 November 11, 1963, and the last time November 17, 1963, and has not returned since that time. When she quiered him as to where he goes he stated that he had gone to Laredo, Texas, across the border from Nuevo Laredo, Mexico, on 1 business. She also said that when he left the last time

and at times imagines things. She is kind-hearted but often gets confuse on data. Mrs. SLICH advised MARKWELL at no time ever mentioned to her being in or near Russia, and appeared to be very anti-Communist in his belief.

On December (, 1063, Mrs. TEFRY HUFF, 318 Arden Drive, San Antonio, advised that sae is the owner of the apartment which EOCER MAPKWELL rented from her on October 31, 1963, at \$35.00 per month. He paid for two weeks and then left on Movember 15, 1963, after telling her that he could not meet the next week's rent. He stated that he had had some bad luck, and had been in an automobile accident and that his car was being repaired and it took all of his money to pay this bill. Mrs. HUFF sivised the address of the apartment where MARKWELL resided is 201 Arden Drive, San Antonio.

A check was made with the Salvation Army in San Antonio on December 6, 1963, and the manager, WALTER MARTIN, advised that they have had no one by the name of MARKWELL, MARTWELL, or BROCKWELL during the month of November, 1963, or up through December 6, 1963.
