Your felter of Federaber 17th has been received.

Unfortunately your comments indicate unfamiliarity with our jurisdiction. I feel it necessary to inform you that the protection of the President and his immediate fandly is the responsibility of the Secret Service of the United States Treasury Department and not the FBI. Secret service agents were with the President at the time he was assar sinated.

Obvious ly, as a rederal investigative agency, it is our obligation to disseminate information coming to our attention which in licates potential danger to the President or his family. In this regard I can assure you the FBI promptly advises the decret service of any data within our possession pertinent to this responsibility; however, the information we had regarding Oswald gave absolutely no clue indicating he was a potential assassin.
