This boy walked up to the cab, he was walking South on Lamar from Commerce, he asked if he could get a cab, I told him, yes, and I opened the back door. He shut the back door and said he wanted to cit in the front. The hoy said he wanted to be to the 500 Block of North Feckley. After we had gotten into the cab and I had turned my meter on, a lady came up to the cab and ask if she could get this cab. As i recall I said there will be one, behind me very soon. I am not sure unbether the man passenger repeated this, to her or not, tut I think he may have. I then drove away. I ask him what all of the sirens were about and he didn't say anything so I didn't say anymoreto him. I turned right on Jackson and traveled to Austin Street where I turned left and traveled Wood Street to Houston Street there is turned right on Wood Street. I traveled Wood Street to Houston Street turned left want over the viaduct to Zangs Blvd. and traveled Zangs to Peckley and turned left and traveled on Feckley until I reached the 500 Block of North Beckley. When I got in the 500 Hock of North Beckley he caid this will do and I stopped The fare was 95 cents and he gave me a dollar and told me to keep the change. The toy got out of the car and walked in front of the cab at an angle south on Backley Street. This boy was small, five feet sight inchos, slender had on a dark shirt with white spots of semathing on it. He had a braclet on his left wrist. He looked like he was 25 or 26 years old. At approximately 2:15 pm this afterneon I viewed a line up of h men in this City Hall. being first duly sworn according to law deposes and says:

I hereby wish to make the following statement of my own free will and. accord to John J. Giuffre, who has identified himself to me as a Special Agent of the United States Secret Service.

On November 22, 1963, at approximately 1:00pm I was standing on the front porch of my office at 501 E. Jefferson Ave., Dallas, Texas, when I heard five gunshots. They seemed to be in a series of two shots followed by a series of three shots. I immediately jumped off the porch and headed toward Patton Street.

While proceeding toward Patton street I saw a man who I later identified at the Dallas Police Department, crossing from the east side of Patton to the west side of the same street. This was close to the intersection of Patton and E. 10th. I went to remaining distance, probably fifty feet in all, to Patton Street, and watched the man come south on Patton on the west side of the street. The man was a not in a dead run, but rather in a good trot. When he reached a point approximately twenty feet north of me, and across the street from me I hollered out to him "man what the hell's going on" or something like that. At that point he slowed his pace slightly and turned and looked at me. He appeared to be very pale but not excited. He had a pistol in his right hand and was carrying it in a "raised pistol position".

I think he answered me, but I could not hear what he said. He also shrugged his shoulders, as if to say he did not know what was happening. As I turned to my left after ne passed, to say something to someone else, I could see the man with the pistol the going through the yard of the apartment house at the northwest corner of Jefferson and Patton. It appeared that he was heading west on Jefferson on the north side of the street. I then proceeded to the scene of the shooting.

After two or three minutes at the shooting scene, I picked up the police officer's service revolver and got the cab driver at the scene to help me try and find the man that I had seen with the pistol. We turned west on 10th and south on Crawdord to Jefferson and then west on Jefferson to Beckley where we turned north. During the time we were on Jefferson, we did not see the man with the pistol.

I have been given an opportunity to make changes and corrections in this statement, and it is true to the best of my knowledge and belief.
