James W. L. at the office of the Sheriff, Atlanta Street, Dallas, Texas, and did then and there depose and say:

W. S., a white male, about 25 years old, on and before said day, I work for the Texas School Book Depository, 101 Elm Street, as a elevator on the tenth floor for Mr. Roy S. Jones, Jr., On Friday, November 22, 1963, I got to work at 6:05 a.m. the first time I saw Lee Oswald on Friday, November 22, 1963 about 8:15 a.m. He was standing outside on the first floor. A little after 9:00 a.m. Lee Oswald asked me what all the people were doing standing on the street. I told him that the President was supposed to come this way sometime this morning. He asked me, "Why do you think he is coming?". I told him that the President would probably come down Main Street and turn on Houston and then go down Elm Street. He said, "Yes, I see". I only talked with him for about three or four minutes. The last time I saw Lee Oswald on Friday, November 22, 1963 was between 11:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon when he was taking the elevator upstairs to get some books. At about 11:30 a.m. all of the employees who were working on the tenth floor were departing and we were all out on the street at about 12:00 o'clock noon. The employees were: Bill Shadley, Charles Gaines, Billie Lovelady, Eddie Kelly (I do not know his name) and a Spanish boy (his name I do not know).
