MALCOLM

My name is Malcolm Howard Price. I am 34 years of age and I live at 1127 Rice St. in Grand Prairie, Texas. I am employed at the present time at Ling-Temco-Vought in Grand Prairie, Texas.

On October 1963 around October 26, 1963 I was helping Mr. Davis at the Sports Drome Gun Range at 8000 W. Davis in Grand Prairie, Tex. I helped Mr. Davis who operates the range for about two weeks. On or about October 28, 1963 at about 5:30pm a person whom I now know as Lee Oswald came to the range and asked if there was anyone who could set the sights on a gun scope. I told him that I could set it for him, then he wanted to know what I would charge to set the sights. I told him it would cost him a \$1.00. I sighted in the scope at 100 yards and in the process fired about twelve shots. Lee Oswald furnished the ammunition. When I got the gun set to where I could put three shots in the bulls eye I told him to try the gun and see if he was satisfied with it. He fired about two rounds and said that it was good enough. The gun had no gun brand on it but it had been made into a sports model. The gun did not have a sling on it. After Oswald had fired the two shots, then he left in a car, make and model I do not know, but I think it was an old model car.

On or about October 30, 1963 I again saw Lee Oswald at the Range at around 5pm or a little later. He was using booth number 4 or 5, shooting his gun at a target. I did not notice what type of gun he was using on this occasion. I did not notice when he left the range. He did not talk to me on this occasion.

On or about November 2, 1963 I again saw Lee Oswald at range shooting his gun. I did not talk to him on this occasion. I did not see when he left. I did not notice what kind of gun he was using.

On November 2, 1963 was the last time I saw Oswald as I did not return to the range anymore except on November 9, 1963 for a turkey shoot. I did not recall seeing Oswald on this occasion.

The reason I know that Lee Oswald was the person I saw at the range was because I have since seen him on television and I am sure he is the one that I have mentioned above.
